Young boy is sitting on the gurney and says to you, “My head hurts.” He has an obvious large swelling on the left side of his head and has vomited 2 X in the ED

Girl is sitting on the gurney talking with her parents and holding her right wrist

**Toddler is having difficulty breathing
- has nasal flaring and audible wheezing.**

4 **Girl hopped in on one foot with help of father. She is not bearing weight on her left leg.**

5 **Boy was carried in by his father and cannot bear weight on his right leg**

6 **Unresponsive cyanotic infant, staring without focus. Mother is crying, “Something fell on my baby’s head!” On inspection, baby is not breathing.**

7 **Alert toddler has obvious laceration on head and swollen right foot**

Young girl, pale, obvious deformity of left upper arm; not breathing, unresponsive

9

Girl is struggling to breathe with circumoral cyanosis. She cannot answer any questions.

10

Pale adolescent boy brought on a gurney groaning and holding his left thigh.

11

Adolescent girl who walked in with multiple cuts on hands and legs

12

Agitated preschool boy brought to ED by paramedics who found him wandering the streets alone 4 hours after the earthquake.

13

Young boy with left orbital ecchymosis, nose bleed and bleeding gums. His upper incisors are displaced backward.

Young semiconscious girl brought in by ambulance, pale

- 15** **Limp infant with dry mouth, sunken eyes, blank stare and tachypnea**
- 16** **Young boy crying with severe pain in his lower left leg which is swollen, red, hot**
- 17** **Adolescent boy with short halting breaths and obvious respiratory distress, holding his left side.**
- 18** **Preteen girl female brought in by ambulance, unable to move right leg**

19 **Healthy appearing active and talkative toddler girl**

20 **Young girl who is sitting on gurney with drooping left shoulder; is hysterically crying in pain.**

21 **Young boy, who is sitting on his mother's lap and holding his hand over right eye**

22 **Young boy sitting on gurney with cuts on his face and arms**

**Young boy sitting on gurney
holding his left arm and talking to

**Preschool girl standing by the
gurney and talking to her
grandmother**

**Preschool girl brought in by
ambulance who cannot feel or move
her legs**

26 **Adolescent boy with difficulty breathing, face contorted in pain**

27 **Teenage boy with compound fracture of left lower leg; says “Hey Doc...can you fix this?”**

28 **Teenage boy brought in by parents after fall with loss of consciousness. He cannot tell you how old he is.**

29

Teenage boy with second and third degree burns; unconscious; unresponsive; not breathing

30

Adolescent girl, smells of smoke, has breathing problems and black soot in her nares
